SHOW RULES:

- Dogs need not be purebred.
- Conformation of dogs not to be judged.
- Uncontrolled or aggressive dogs will be asked to leave.
- Bitches in season will not be permitted to compete.
- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times when not in show ring.
- Members will compete in appropriate Club Uniform. (See Livestock Department for definition of uniform).
- Members and their dogs must have clean appearance in the ring.
- Dogs must not be taken near the cattle, goat, sheep, swine, poultry, rabbits, horse barns and show rings.
- Clean up after your dog immediately.
- Equipment will be available near the show ring.
- **No Pinch Collars/Haltz-ez allowed in show.**
- **Belt Buckle for highest points overall showmanship/health score.**

Section 1: SHOWING AND FITTING

~~Members should know how to set dog up in proper pose, know the three (3) gaiting patterns, be familiar with the parts of the dog, health care and breed history. Guidelines for a Club Dog Show classes may be obtained from County Agricultural Extension Office.

Class:

1. Primary Showmanship Exhibition ONLY, 5-9 years old, currently enrolled in a Club

Novice Showmanship:

- For Members who have not won three (3) 1st Place awards at a Youth Club Dog Show.

Classes:

2. Novice Showmanship – Members age 9-12
3. Novice Showmanship – Members age 13-19

Open Showmanship:

- For Members who have won three (3) 1st Place awards in Novice Showmanship at a Youth Club Dog Show.

Classes:

4. Open Showmanship - Members age 12 and under

5. Open Showmanship – Members age 13 and over

(Eyes, ears, teeth, nails, coat)

(Appearance of handler, smooth and after handling, knowledge of ring procedure)

SECTION 2: OBEDIENCE

PRE SUB- NOVICE:

- First time to compete in a Youth Club Dog Show. Controlled walking, figure 8, stand for examination with handler at dog's side, recall (no front or finish required, sits and downs as in a sub-novice).

Class:

1. Primary Club Obedience

SUB-NOVICE 1:

- First time to compete in a Youth Dog Show. Dogs having a leg toward or a C.D. MAY NOT COMPETE IN ANY Sub-Novice Classes. Controlled walking, figure 8, stand for examination with handler at dog's side, recall (no front or finished required), sits (1 minute) and down (3 minutes) on leash.

Classes:

2. Sub- Novice 1 – Members 12 years and under
3. Sub- Novice 1 – Members 13 years and over

SUB – NOVICE 2:

- For exhibitors that have not yet shown three (3) times with the same dog at a Youth Club Dog show prior to this show.

Classes:

4. Sub-Novice 2 – Members 12 years and under
5. Sub-Novice 2 – Members 13 years and over

GRADUATE SUB- NOVICE:

- Heeling and figure 8 on lead, stand recall, sits and downs as in Novice. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT be shown in any other obedience class.

Classes:

6. Graduate Sub – Novice – Members 12 years and under
7. Graduate Sub – Novice - Members 12 years and over

Novice:

- Dogs that have C.D. MAY NOT enter this class. Heeling figure 8 on leash, stand for examination, heeling, recall, sits (1 minute) and downs (3 minutes) off leash.

Classes:

8. Novice – Members 12 years and under
9. Novice – Members 13 years and over

GRADUATE NOVICE:

- Dogs will be expected to perform exercises listed in Sub-Novice and Novice, plus heel free through figure 8, drop and recall, long sit (3 minutes), long down (5 minutes), with the handler out of sight. Dogs who have a leg towards their C.D.X. MAY NOT compete in this class.

Classes:

- Graduate Novice- Members 12 years and under
- Graduate Novice- Members 13 years and older
- Fun Class – time permitting. Information will be available day of the show.
- Dress your dog in beach wear
