- **ENTRY LIMIT: 2 items per class per exhibitor. (All items must be entered in their most appropriate class. Additional items exceeding limit in a given class but entered in other classes may be subject to disqualification).**
- **NOTE:** Exhibitors who will be entering the same items in both the Monterey County Fair and Santa Cruz County Fair may have their items held upon release from Monterey and delivered to receiving at Santa Cruz on their behalf. If this service is desired, please designate such on **each** of the respective county entry forms.
- **INDIVIDUALS** who have placed first in a class 3 or more times at the Santa Cruz County Fair should indicate "MASTERS" on that sections entry.
